Youth will meet this Wednesday, January 5.

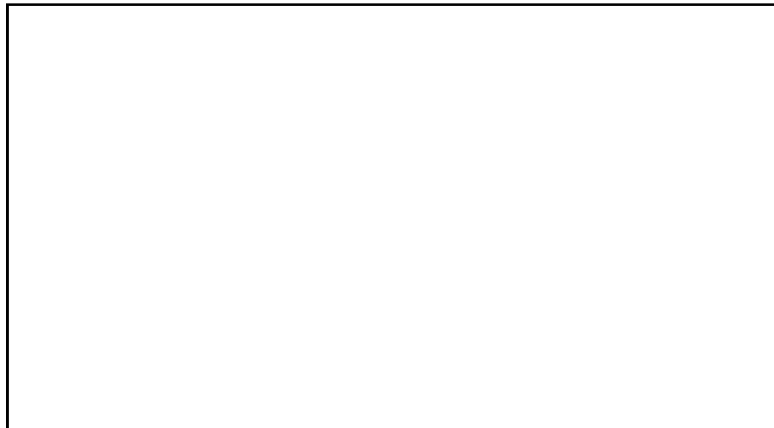
Reminder for winter: When city and/or county schools are closed due to weather, there will be no youth that evening.
