Children's Ministry Information – All children, infants through 5th grade, meet in the lower level.

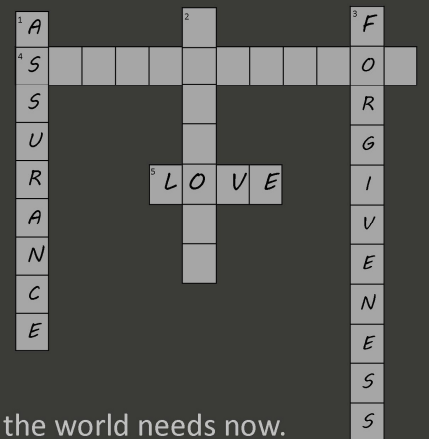
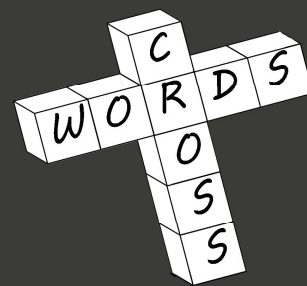
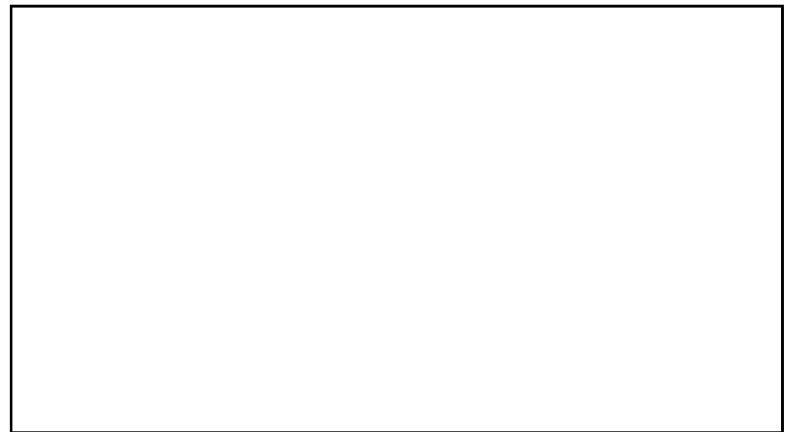
