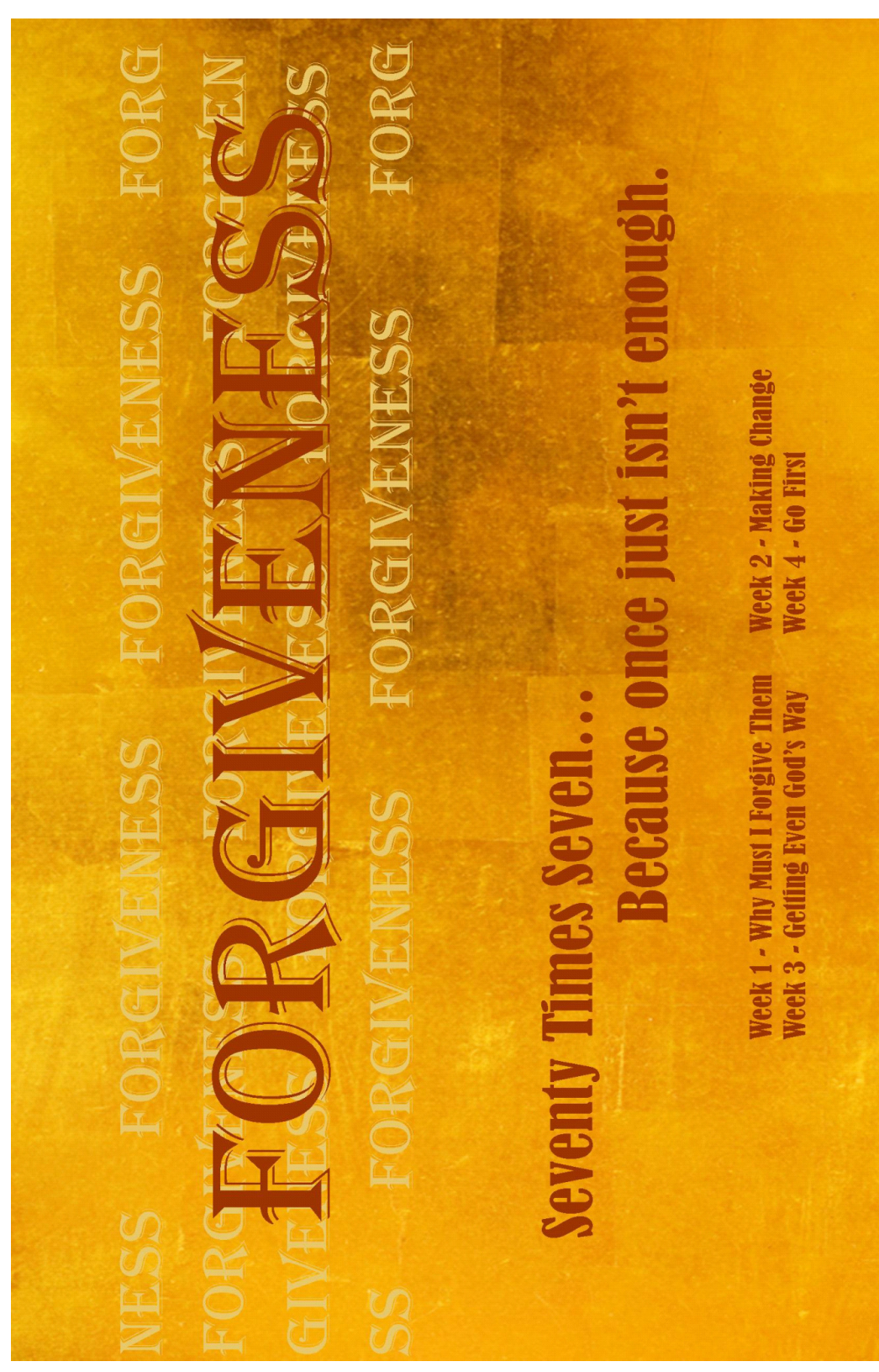
Because of your generosity, we were able to donate 425 backpacks to the Family Resource Center!
